

Table DIY in 4 Easy Steps by Julia Crawford



- 1.** rescue a five panel wood door (32"x80") from salvage yard and clean it up, varnish it, or leave it rough (I simply cleaned it up with household wood cleaner, left it rough, that's the look I wanted)



- 2.** screw in four 27" tall +/- IKEA table legs, one at each corner, set in about 3" from the short ends



- 3.** lay decorative paper in the panels, do not glue, simply cut paper to size and lay in.



4. top with 3/8" sheet of tempered glass (found at an auto repair shop). the weight of the glass is enough to keep it in place. if you purchase the glass, it can get pricey, but for a custom table that is a conversation piece and work of art, 150\$ may be worth it.
